Intro:
Get into the car
Gear shift will be in park (P)
Adjust Seat; adjust mirrors
Fasten seat belt
Step on the brake
Step on the gas pedal (accelerator)
Turn right and left turn signals (blinkers) on
Honk the horn
Turn on the headlights; turn off
Turn on the emergency lights; turn off
Lower the window
Turn on the windshield wipers; turn on washer fluid to clean windshield; turn off
Identify the following:
Ignition switch
Gear shift
Speedometer; odometer
Fuel gauge
Emergency brake
Sun visor, glove box or compartment
Air conditioner, heater and drfroster controls
Radio

Directions given during driving practice:

Turn on the car, put the car in drive (D) or reverse (R)

Turn right at the next street; turn left at the next street

Turn right at the next corner; turn left at the next corner or the one coming up

Turn right at the stop sign

Pull over to the curb; pull away from the curb

Pull over to the shoulder

Pull in to (pull up to) the parking spot

Parallel park behind that car

Change to the righ/left lane (move over to the right/left lane); use mirrors and look over shoulder when changing lanes

Back up; look over right shoulder when backing up

Pull into parking lot

Turn right (or left) onto S Grand; turn right (or left) at the light

Go, speed up, go faster; wait, slow down, go slower, STOP

Go forward, go sstraight

Come to a full or complete stop, not a 'rolling' stop

Watch your blind spot

Be aware of your surroundings

Don't tailgate and don't use your cell phone
